

Desktop Pictures Using iPhoto 6

- ✓ In iPhoto, create a folder called Desktop Pics (File > New Folder)
- ✓ Place any pictures that you want to set as your desktop in this folder

To set one picture only:

- ✓ Select the picture
- ✓ Share (menu bar across top)
- ✓ Desktop

To select random pictures from your Desktop Pics folder:

- ✓ Deselect any pictures inside the folder that may be selected
- ✓ Make sure the Desktop Pics folder is selected
- ✓ Share (menu bar across top)
- ✓ Desktop

A window will open allowing you to set preferences:

- Dropdown menu to fill screen, stretch to fill screen, tile, or center
- Change picture every so many minutes
- Select Random order box or not

Desktop Pictures Using iPhoto 4 or 2

- ✓ In iPhoto, create an album called Desktop Pics (File > New Album)
- ✓ Place any pictures that you want to set as your desktop in this folder
- ✓ Open System Preferences
- ✓ Desktop & ScreenSaver
- ✓ Desktop
- ✓ On the left you'll see a list of 2 sections with a gray dividing line. **Under** the gray line, locate your Desktop Pics folder and select it.
- ✓ Choose one picture to select it as your desktop picture or select the folder and set your options:
 - Dropdown menu to fill screen, stretch to fill screen, tile, or center
 - Change picture every so many minutes
 - Select Random order box or not
